The Management Committee can suspend membership by giving written notice for such reasons as: ceasing to live in the area, or not attending a meeting for over 12 months.

The OBJECTS (Purpose) of WCDG

The promotion of the public benefit of urban regeneration in an area of social and economic deprivation and in particular in Waterloo and adjoining areas ("the area of benefit") by all or any of the following means:

1. the relief of poverty
2. the relief of unemployment
3. the provision of recreational facilities and facilities for other leisure-time occupations for the public at large or those who by reason of their youth, age, infirmity or disablement, poverty or social or economic circumstances have need of such facilities
4. the promotion of good health
5. the protection, conservation and improvement of the environment and the preservation of buildings of historical or architectural importance
6. the promotion of public safety and the prevention of crime
7. the advancement of education and training with reference to urban planning, urban transport and the protection, conservation and improvement of the environment
8. the creation of training and employment opportunities by the provision of works, space, buildings and /or land for use on favourable terms
9. such other means as may from time to time be determined subject to prior written consent of the Charity Commission.
10. To develop the capacity and skills of the members of the community in the area of benefit in such a way that they are better able to identify and help meet their needs and to participate more fully in society.

The POLICIES of WCDG

1. retaining a viable and permanent residential community in Waterloo
2. redressing the imbalance of land uses (too little useful open space and permanent households, etc, and too much dense development, commercialisation, advertising, etc)
3. increasing the amount of permanent housing, especially for young families
4. increasing and improving the amount of useful, green public open space
5. retaining and increasing useful retail shopping (that which supports family life)
6. retaining the viability of Lower Marsh shopping centre and the market stalls
7. retaining and improving the library service in Waterloo
8. creating a better environment (safer, greener, cleaner)
9. providing better indoor and outdoor facilities for the local children and young people
10. providing better facilities to support community activities (offering free meeting places etc)
11. supporting an increase in safety and reduction in crime
12. controlling traffic pollution and reducing through traffic
13. reducing non-resident parking
14. relocating the bus garage (because of pollution and danger)
15. a ban on coaches waiting or parking
16. no land being used for off street parking at ground level
17. safe and convenient ground level crossings for pedestrians
18. good planning policies to achieve the above
19. consistent implementation of these policies
20. effective and thorough consultation with the residential community
